

## Notice of Public Meeting

All interested persons are hereby given notice that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to improve the I-35 and I-240 Interchange in Oklahoma City. A public Meeting is scheduled for 6:30 pm, Thursday, August 28, 2003 at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, Oklahoma City Residency located at, 1021 S.E. 59th Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

The existing I-35/I-240 Interchange is a low-speed clover-leaf design that is experiencing major congestion and operational issues. The Department proposes to reconstruct the interchange to improve safety, operational function, and capacity. The purpose of the informal meeting is to discuss improvements that would best meet the current and future travel demands in the area and to request information from the public to further assist in the evaluation of critical social, economic, and environmental effects that may result from the project.
