ODOT to host public meeting on SH-51 East Beaver Creek Bridge, July 29 in Mulhull

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration is proposing to improve SH-51 bridge over East Beaver Creek and the SH-51/US-77 Junction in Logan County. As part of efforts to keep the public informed of this project and involved in the decision process, ODOT has scheduled a public meeting at:

The meeting will include a presentation about the proposed improvements and why they are needed as well as the expected impacts to motorists and the surrounding community. The purpose of this meeting is to get public input on the proposed improvements prior to final design and construction.

The proposed project will correct the structurally deficient bridge, address the curves and hills on SH-51, improve the SH-51/US-77 junction and provide adequate vertical clearance under the railroad bridge.
