Thanks to these investments, ODOT has delivered numerous improvements to meet the state's most pressing transportation needs in a fiscally responsible manner through its Eight-year Construction Work Plan. Most importantly, this has allowed ODOT to address the state's backlog of bad highway bridges, reducing the number of structurally deficient bridges by more than half since 2004. Along with bridges, future transportation needs include improving pavement conditions and major highway corridors, adding shoulders to narrow two-lane highways and installing more miles of cable barrier.

Throughout the past two decades, ODOT has talked to many groups of community leaders about the importance of transportation to Oklahoma's success and looks forward to continuing in that role.
