Input sought on SH-66 / I-44 (Turner Turnpike) project

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation and the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority invite the public to attend a meeting on the proposed replacement of the SH-66 bridge over I-44 (Turner Turnpike) as public input is needed before any plans are finalized.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation and OTA are asking for any ideas on how this project could impact social, economic, and the environment in this area. The exact location of the bridge is 4.5 miles southwest of Kellyville. Final design and right-of-way requirements for this proposal have not been determined.

Both ODOT and the OTA will host a public meeting Thursday, October 25, 2007 at 5:30 p.m., in the Community Conference Room of the Bristow Public Library. The meeting will start at 5:30 p.m. followed by a short presentation and a question and answer session. The address is 111 West 7th Ave., Bristow. Representatives from these agencies, along with the design and engineering firms will be on hand to discuss the project.
