## **WEEKLY UPDATE – Remember ODOT website, shuttle schedule extends tentatively, repair work continues**

With repairs on the bridge in full swing, please check the Oklahoma Department of Transportation’s website daily for updates on information and shuttle schedules. The website is located at [www.okladot.state.ok.us](http://www.okladot.state.ok.us). Click on the red “Closing of the Purcell/Lexington (James C. Nance) bridge on US-77/SH-39” banner.

The shuttle has been tentatively extended to include additional times Monday through Friday. The added pickup times include 1:30 p.m., 3:30 p.m., 10 p.m. and 11 p.m. at both Purcell and Lexington locations. The late evening times are being tested to gauge ridership, and could be amended depending on needs in the communities. The shuttle will arrive at its destination about an hour after departure.

The weather has been cooperating with repair efforts. Even though areas of the state have seen some rain recently, the river has not risen significantly. Crews are currently working over the river and will be moving outward toward the banks. They want to get this area completed while the river is low, because high water or flooding could impact work.

It is still too early to estimate when the bridge will be opened, but work is moving smoothly with the contractor installing brackets as soon as they become available and pre-drilling areas for quicker repairs.
