ODOT holding Purcell/Lexington bridge public input meeting on April 2

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration is hosting a public meeting to present information and solicit public input on a future project to replace the US-77/SH-39 bridge between Purcell and Lexington.

Purcell/Lexington Bridge Public Meeting

The James C. Nance bridge crosses the South Canadian River and BNSF railroad between Purcell and Lexington, is structurally deficient and currently load posted. The bridge is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

As part of ODOT's efforts to keep the public informed and involve them in the decision making process, this meeting will present proposed alternatives to the public and get public input to aid ODOT in selecting a preferred alternative to move forward with the completion of the detailed environmental studies, design and construction.

A construction project to replace the bridge has been recently expedited in ODOT's Eightyear Construction Work Plan to go to bid in Federal Fiscal Year 2018.
