I-40 narrows in Weatherford Monday, July 7 as resurfacing, interchange project begins

Beginning Monday, drivers can expect various lane closures on east and westbound I-40 between Mile Marker 76, approximately four miles west of SH-54, and Airport Rd. (Mile Marker 84) in Weatherford for pavement resurfacing and interchange reconstruction at Washington St. The project will take approximately one year to complete. The existing eastbound I-40 off-ramp to Main St. will remain open to traffic. Drivers should plan extra travel time and be alert to workers and equipment in the area.

In March, the Oklahoma Transportation Commission awarded a contract with a base bid of \$16.7 million and potential financial incentives for early completion for this project to Haskell Lemon Construction Co. of Oklahoma City.

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
