SH-266 bridge replacement project begins Monday in Rogers County

A \$3.5 million project to replace the structurally deficient SH-266 bridge at the Verdigris River Overflow is scheduled to begin Monday, Feb. 9. This is located east of Keetonville Road and just east of the Verdigris River.

During the first phase of work, crews will build a temporary bridge south of the existing structure. This will allow traffic to continue flowing in this corridor throughout the replacement project. Drivers should be alert to crews and equipment and also to a reduced speed limit of 45 m.p.h. in this area.

The overall project is expected to complete in late 2015, weather permitting.
