US-77 narrows in Murray Co. for two bridge rehabilitation projects

North and southbound US-77 will be narrowed to one lane just north of SH-7 at Davis starting Wednesday, June 18 until October for a bridge rehabilitation project at Chigley Sandy Creek. Portable traffic signals will direct vehicles through the work zone.

Once work is complete at Chigley Sandy Creek, north and southbound US-77 will be narrowed to one lane just south of SH-17A near Wynnewood from October to February for a bridge rehabilitation project at Kickapoo Sandy Creek.

Drivers are asked to pay close attention to construction signs and plan for extra travel time in the area.

Additionally, wide loads over 10 feet will be restricted during construction.
