**Lanes, ramps to close at Sheridan Rd., Ft. Sill Blvd. gate to reopen
in Lawton**

Beginning just after midnight Saturday night, May 1, contractors with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation will close northbound Sheridan Rd., north of Rogers Ln./US-62 until summer as construction continues on an intersection improvement project. Message boards will be in place to direct traffic.

Rogers Ln./US-62 traffic will not have any access to northbound Sheridan Rd., however access to southbound Sheridan Rd. will be available. Rogers Ln./US-62 traffic accessing southbound Sheridan Rd. will find it narrowed to one lane for approximately two blocks.

For traffic leaving Ft. Sill, Sheridan Rd. will be closed at the Sheridan Rd. gate.

As the Sheridan Rd. gate closes, the Ft. Sill Blvd. gate will reopen and be accessible 24 hrs. a day during the Sheridan Rd. construction.

Drivers should remain alert to construction signs, use caution traveling through the area and plan an alternate route around closures.

The \$1.3 million project was awarded to T & G Construction in Lawton for Rogers Ln./US-62 intersection reconstruction and signalization improvements at Ft. Sill Blvd. and Sheridan Rd.

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
