**Statewide 2005, 2006, 2007 and National 2007 Statistics**

**OKLAHOMA 2007**

- ▶ 21 people were killed in Oklahoma highway work zones in 2007
- ▶ This is the most Oklahoma work zone deaths since 2002, when 22 people were killed
- ▶ Also in 2007, 688 people were injured in 1142 collisions in Oklahoma work zones
- ▶ Most collisions resulted from following too close, traveling at unsafe speeds and driver inattention

**NATIONWIDE 2007**

- ▶ In 2007, 835 people were killed in highway work zone collisions nationwide
- ▶ This is down from 2006, when 1,004 people were killed in work zone collisions.

**OKLAHOMA 2006**

- ▶ 16 people were killed in Oklahoma work zones in 2006
- ▶ 399 people were injured in 769 collisions

**OKLAHOMA 2005**

- ▶ 10 people were killed in Oklahoma work zones in 2005
- ▶ 506 people were injured in 813 collisions
