Pursuant to Title 69 Oklahoma Statutes (2011), Section 1001, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation offers the following property for sale by sealed bid to the highest bidder. Bid proposals sent by REGISTERED MAIL will be received through the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, Facilities Management Division on September 19, 2019 until 1:30 PM. Hand Delivered bids will be received at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Building, Facilities Management Division, 200 NE 21st Street, Room B-7, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 on September 19, 2019 until 1:30 PM. Bids will be opened and publicly read at 1:30 PM.

Description of Property:

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in part of the W1/2 SE1/4 SW1/4 of Section 28, T4N, R5E in Pontotoc County, Oklahoma. Said parcel of land being described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of said W1/2 SE1/4 SW1/4, thence S 00°30'00" E along the East line of said W1/2 SE1/4 SW1/4 a distance of 887.30 feet to a point on the present Northerly right-of-way line of State Highway No. 19, thence N 63°07'34" W along said right-of-way line a distance of 124.14 feet, thence N 67°06'01" W along said right-of-way line a distance of 321.39 feet, thence N 04°38'10" E a distance of 115.33 feet, thence N 04°30'38" W a distance of 590.32 feet to a point on the North line of said W1/2 SE1/4 SW1/4, thence N 89°37'35" E along said North line a distance of 436.16 feet to point of beginning.

Containing 7.54 acres, more or less.

NOTE: The intent of this instrument is to convey a portion of the property described in Book 2800, Pages 216-217 and recorded on November 22, 2013 in the Pontotoc County Clerk's Office, less and except the 0.49 acres for highway rights-of-way along the Southerly side of the abutting State Highway No. 19.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation has set the **minimum bid** requirement at **\$36,600.00** for this sale. The parcel is being sold "**as is**", with the buyer being responsible for their own due diligence in regards to zoning, licenses, permits, environmental, land uses, etc.

Terms of the sale are ten percent (10%) of the bid price in **non-refundable certified funds** and must accompany each bid in the form of a bid deposit. The balance of the bid will be due in certified funds within thirty (30) calendar days after the approval by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission. **Deposits submitted by non-successful bidders will be returned.** The successful high bidder will also be required to pay for any and all advertising costs associated with the sale of this land. After approval of the sale, an executed and recorded Quitclaim Deed will be mailed to the highest bidder. **IMPORTANT: ENCLOSE BID IN ENVELOPE AS PROVIDED.**
