Pursuant to Title 69 Oklahoma Statutes (2011), Section 1001, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation offers the following property for sale by sealed bid to the highest bidder. Bid proposals sent by REGISTERED MAIL will be received through the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, Facilities Management Division on **November 14, 2019 until 1:00 p.m.** Hand Delivered bids will be received at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Building, Facilities Management Division, 200 N.E. 21st Street, Room 1-B7, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 on **November 14, 2019 until 1:30 p.m.** The bids will be opened and immediately read publicly on **November 14, 2019 at 1:30 p.m.** in the ODOT Project Management Conference Room located at the address above.

Description of Property:

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in Block 6 of Lake View Terrace as platted in the NW/4 of Section 33, T16N, R2W, in Logan County, Oklahoma. Said parcel of land being described as follows:

*Commencing at the SE Comer of said Block 6; thence S89 °42'22"W, along the south line of said Block 6, a distance of 411.87 feet; thence on a non-tangent curve to the right having a radius of 2719.75 feet and an arc length of 110.39 feet (having a chord of N43°11'34"W - 110.38 feet) to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**; thence on a non-tangent curve to the right having a radius of 2719.75 feet and an arc length of 113.32 feet (having a chord of N40 °50'11" W - 113.31 feet); thence N89°42'23"E, along the north line of said Block 6, a distance of 178.29 feet; thence along a non-tangent curve to the left having a radius of 796.22 feet and an arc length of 135.67 feet (having a chord of S 50 °15'17" W - 135.51 feet) to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.*

Containing 0.17 acres (7461.60 square feet) more or less.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation has set the **minimum bid** requirement at **\$1,045.00** for this sale. The parcel is being sold "**as is-where is**", with the buyer being responsible for their own due diligence in regards to zoning, licenses, permits, environmental, land uses, etc.

Terms of the sale are ten percent (10%) of the bid price in **non-refundable certified funds** and must accompany each bid in the form of a bid deposit. The balance of the bid will be due in certified funds within thirty (30) calendar days after the approval by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission. **Deposits submitted by non-successful bidders will be returned.** The successful high bidder will also be required to pay for any and all advertising costs associated with the sale of this land. After approval of the sale, an executed and recorded Quitclaim Deed will be mailed to the highest bidder. **IMPORTANT: LABEL THE OUTSIDE OF THE ENVELOPE WITH "SEALED BID".**
