Sixteen communities statewide completed applications during the 2011-2013 Safe Routes to School (SRTS) application cycle. Communities competed for a share of approximately \$3 million dollars for engineering projects and educational programs designed to enable and encourage school children to walk or bicycle to school safely.

What's next?

The SRTS Project Selection Committee completed their evaluation of submitted projects July 27, 2012. Their recommendations for project funding will now go to the Oklahoma Transportation Commission for approval.
