OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR LONGITUDINAL JOINT DENSITY ON ASPHALT CONCRETE PAVEMENT

These Special Provisions revise, amend and where in conflict, supersede applicable sections of the <u>Standard</u> <u>Specifications for Highway Construction, English and Metric</u>, as applicable. Units of measurement are provided in the subsections in English only.

(add the following:)

411.04 CONSTRUCTION METHODS.

(j)(2)(2.3) Longitudinal Joint Density. For each lot, or sublot at locations where roadway density tests are to be taken, perform a joint density evaluation at each pavement edge that is or will become a longitudinal joint. Determine the joint density in accordance with OHD L-14, Appendix C. The joint density is considered failing if the density at the joint is more than 3.0 pcf below the density at the random sample location at the same station and the measured (by core or correlation) joint density is less than 90%.

Investigate joint density failures and take corrective actions during production and placement to improve the joint density. Suspend production if two (2) consecutive evaluations fail unless otherwise approved. Resume production after the Engineer approves changes to production or placement methods.
