NEW RELEASE TO BE INSTALLED IN DECEMBER

All of transport will be updated to version 3.9b on Saturday, December 4, 2010. Please have your computers turned on and docked so the new version can be installed. All information in the standalone mode needs to be placed on the server. Sitemanager will no longer work on your computer if it is not upgraded.

DBE REPORTS TO BE PLACED IN SITEMANAGER

On December 4, 2010, the access to the Subcontract Window will be inquiry only. In order to enter in the DBE payments you will need to proceed to the Civil Rights section of the main panel. There you can enter in the DBE reports. This report will provide a tracking history of all entries made into Sitemanager. WHAT'S UP W/SITEMANAGER, WINDOWS 7 & TABLET PC

There are a few issues with Sitemanager and Windows 7. The main problem has been pipelining. As far as we know all other functions appear to be working normally. On the tablet, however, we encourage you to use terminal service or TS to complete any Sitemanager transactions.

PASSWORD PROTECTION -WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO YOU

Your Sitemanager password is like your signature. You would not give a copy of your signature to someone so they could go down to the bank and withdraw money from your account. Giving someone your Sitemanager password is like signing a legal document that says you are responsible for what was entered into the computer. If you had to go into court of law, the person that you gave your password to is not liable - you are.

The specifications state in Section 220.04.H that "no exposed area shall remain unprotected for more than 14 calendar days without being stabilized". So, please require that your Contractor complies with that requirement and let's start using the Vegetative Mulch!!
