

# NOTICE TO BIDDERS

## Bid Request for Asphalt Road Paving

**LOCATION: Pine Street beginning at Simpson Road and continuing south to the intersection of Charter Oak Road. Total laydown of approximately 1 mile.**

County Commissioner shall act as project engineer and make the final inspection and acceptance or rejection. Payment for work is subject to quality assurance and approval by the Logan County Board of Commissioners and all work must include the following specifications:

- ✓ Contractor to furnish labor, equipment and all materials
- ✓ Asphalt to be compacted to 95% density
- ✓ Contractor responsible for all traffic control devices during the construction and will supply them as needed.
- ✓ Type S4 mixed asphalt will be used and contain no more than 25% recycled asphalt
- ✓ The screed shall effectively produce a finished surface of the required evenness and texture without tearing, shoving or gouging the mixture. Any irregularity in the laydown surface is to be corrected by the contractor at once.
- ✓ Paving schedule to be negotiated between District 2 Commissioner and contractor. Contractor to provide one week notice prior to project commencement. Phone call is acceptable.
- ✓ Asphalt tickets (originals) showing product totals are to be mailed to 1550 N. Midwest Blvd., Guthrie, OK 73044, upon paving completion.
- ✓ A Certificate of Insurance will be required before work begins showing the contractor has Workers Compensation and Public Liability Insurance as required by the laws of the State of Oklahoma.
