and that he has reached a full understanding of everything required on said Plans and Specifications, and that he has informed himself as to the kind and quantities of various materials to be furnished and/or the nature and location of the work to be done, and all other matters affecting the work.

The undersigned bidder proposes and agrees that if his proposal is accepted, to enter into contract with the County, on forms prescribed, with approved sureties, within seven (7) days, after notice of award to execute the Contract, and to furnish to the County a satisfactory Performance and Statutory Bond in the sum of 100% of the contract price, guaranteeing the faithful performance of the work and payment of bills.

To do any extra work not covered by the following schedule of prices or stipulated lump sum price which may be ordered by the Engineer and to accept as full compensation therefor such prices as may be agreed upon in writing by the Engineer and the Contractor in accordance with Section 108.04 of the General Provisions.

It is further agreed that the Contractor shall begin the work on the date indicated in the Notice to Proceed and to prosecute said work in such a manner as to complete all work contracted for within <u>120</u> calendar days following the Notice to Proceed. The Notice to Proceed shall become effective within 30 calendar days of the bid opening.

The Contractor shall take out and maintain public liability insurance in accordance with Section 106.25 of the General Provisions of the Specifications. A copy of said Specifications is now on file in the Office of the County Clerk.

Upon completion of the Contract, the Contractor shall furnish to the County a satisfactory Maintenance Bond in the amount of 100% of the final contract price, guaranteeing the maintenance of the work for a period of **ONE** (1) year after acceptance by the County.

All of these documents have been provided to and/or by the Contractor and are on file in the Office of the County Clerk. Hereinafter, these documents shall be collectively referred to as "Bidding Documents."

- 2. <u>Engagement of Contractor</u>. The County hereby engages Contractor to perform certain construction services for the benefit of the County. Contractor accepts such engagement pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein.
- 3. <u>Scope of Engagement</u>. Contractor shall, in a good and first-class, workmanlike manner, at its own cost and expense, furnish all labor, materials, tools and equipment required to perform and complete said work in strict accordance with the Bidding Documents, with the following additions and/or exceptions: (if none, so state.)

- 4. Payments to Contractor. The County shall make payments to the Contractor in the following manner:
 - a. On or about the first (1st) day of each month, the Engineer, or other appropriate person, will make accurate estimates of the value, based on contract prices, of the work done and materials incorporated in the work and of materials suitably stored at the site thereof during the preceding calendar month. The Contractor shall furnish to the Engineer such detailed information as he may request to aid him as a guide in the preparation of the monthly estimates. Ninety-five percent (95%) of such estimated sum shall be paid to the Contractor within five (5) days after the first regularly scheduled meeting of the County of the following month.
 - b. On completion of the work, but prior to the acceptance thereof by the County, it shall be the duty of the Engineer for the County, or other appropriate person, to determine that said work has been completely and fully performed in accordance with this Contract and all incorporated documents; and upon making such determination, said official shall make his final certification to the County.
 - c. The Contractor shall furnish proof that all claims and obligations incurred by him in connection with the performance of said work have been fully paid and settled; said information shall be in the form of an affidavit, which shall bear the approval of the surety on the contract bonds, for payment of the final estimate to the Contractor; thereupon, the final estimate (including retainage, but less any liquidated damages), will be approved and paid, within five (5) days after the first regularly scheduled meeting of the County of the following month.
- 5. <u>Bargaining</u>. The County and the Contractor have had the opportunity to seek independent legal counsel before entering into this Contract. The language of this Contract shall be construed simply, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against either party.
- 6. <u>Third Party Beneficiaries</u>. Nothing in this Contract, expressed or implied, is intended to confer upon any person other than the parties hereto and their respective assigns, any rights or remedies under or by reason of this Contract, except as provided expressly herein.







GENERAL NOTES

The roud will be closed to troffic during construction of the bridge. Type III barricade and advance warning signs will be required at each end of the bridge construction zone and at road intersections each side of Bridge site. The county shall be responsible for placement and maintenance of all construction signs, barricade, lights, etc. according to the standards set forth in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009 Edition. All cost of necessary items for construction signing will be included inter Items of work.

All construction and materials shall be in accordance with the 2009 Oklahama Standards Specifications for Highway Construction.

Equipment for driving piles shall meet the requirements of Section 514.03 of the Standard Specifications. Length of piling shown is estimated. Piling under bridge seat shall have a capacity of 30 tons. Piling buildups, if required, with be paid for at the unit price bid for steel piling.

Bidders shall be responsible for the construction of the bridge using materials provided by the county.

Bidders may bid on the 79' steel beam type bridge shown on the plans or may bid other alternate types of bridge structures provided they meet the approval of the Engineer and the County Commission and provide equivalent clear roadway, waterway opening, and safety features as shown on the plans. If a bridge design different from those shown in the plans is low bid the contractor sholl submit complete plans and specifications prepared by a registered engineer for review and approval by the County Commission prior to the award of contract. The County Commission reserves the right to reject any alternate type bridge or alternate design features which in their judgement would not provide a structure at this location which is equivalent to that shown on the plans.

The bid is good until the completion of the project.

The Top of Deck elevation should be approximately 18 feet above the Flowline elevation of the creek.

The new bridge alignment is to be approved by County Commissioner or the Engineer.

All material will be delivered to the project site by the county.

The contractor shall cut all of the beams to the required length and weld two beams together over the pier. All costs associated with this work will be included in the price bid for bridge construction.


