Tack coat to be applied prior to each lift of asphalt being placed for both Base Bid and Add Alternate.

Add Alternate (178th St. to 220th St.)

1" S-6 (PG64-22) leveling course 2,500 Tons

2" S-4 (PG64-22) Surfacing course 5,000 Tons

2 ½" S-3 (64-22) asphalt overlay (approx. 23' wide) on Calumet Rd. from Memorial Rd. north 3 miles to 178th St.
