3. Unit prices will be guaranteed correct by the bidder. Items & services on this bid will be awarded separately to the lowest/best bidder as determined by the county. County reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids. Successful bidders must verify workers' compensation coverage & general liability of company & outsource. Successful vendors should invoice each district separately & show delivery locations.

**BID SPECIFICATIONS FOR SOUTH 161ST WEST AVE.
ASPHALT OVERLAY PROJECT**

Work to be complete: Asphalt overlay on South 161st West Avenue from West 61st Street South to West 71st Street South. Contractor will be responsible for providing all materials, labor and equipment to complete the asphalt overlay. Contractor will be responsible for all signage, blocking/barricading from the beginning of work until completion. The road is 20' wide and approximately one mile in length. Contractor shall install new asphalt at a depth of 2 inches, cutting in intersections and adjoining roads.

Materials to be used: Type C Asphalt and tack oil.
