5. This bid is submitted as a legal offer and any bid when accepted by the County constitutes a firm contract.
6. Oklahoma laws require **EACH BIDDER** submitting a bid to a county for goods or services to furnish a **NOTARIZED** sworn statement of non-collusion. A form is supplied below.
