The following specifications applies to each bridge.

Pre-Bid Meeting

Non-Mandatory

Time: 10:00 a.m.

Location: Noble County District #1 Shop

Contractor-Each Bridge

- 1 Drive 10 abutment piles and 4 wing piles - 10" H piling
- 2 Cut piles to length determined by Noble County
- 3 Weld in one row of back wall bracing and two rows of wing bracing 8" channel iron
- 4 Drive and cut interlock sheeting
- 5 Set and weld to the piles a complete bridge deck 26'6" W x 25' L
- 6 Cap the interlock with 3x5 angle iron
- 7 Cap wing wall with 10" channel iron


Noble County-Each Bridge

- Will provide and maintain all road closed signs.
- Will take the old bridge out
- Will build the approach's back after bridge is complete
- Will deliver all steel and bridge deck to the bridge sight
- Will provide and finish the concrete
- Will install guard rail

Notes-Each Bridge

- Steel piles shall be driven to a minimum bearing of 30 tons and so that the bottom of the piles are a minimum of 10' below the creek flow line elevation.
