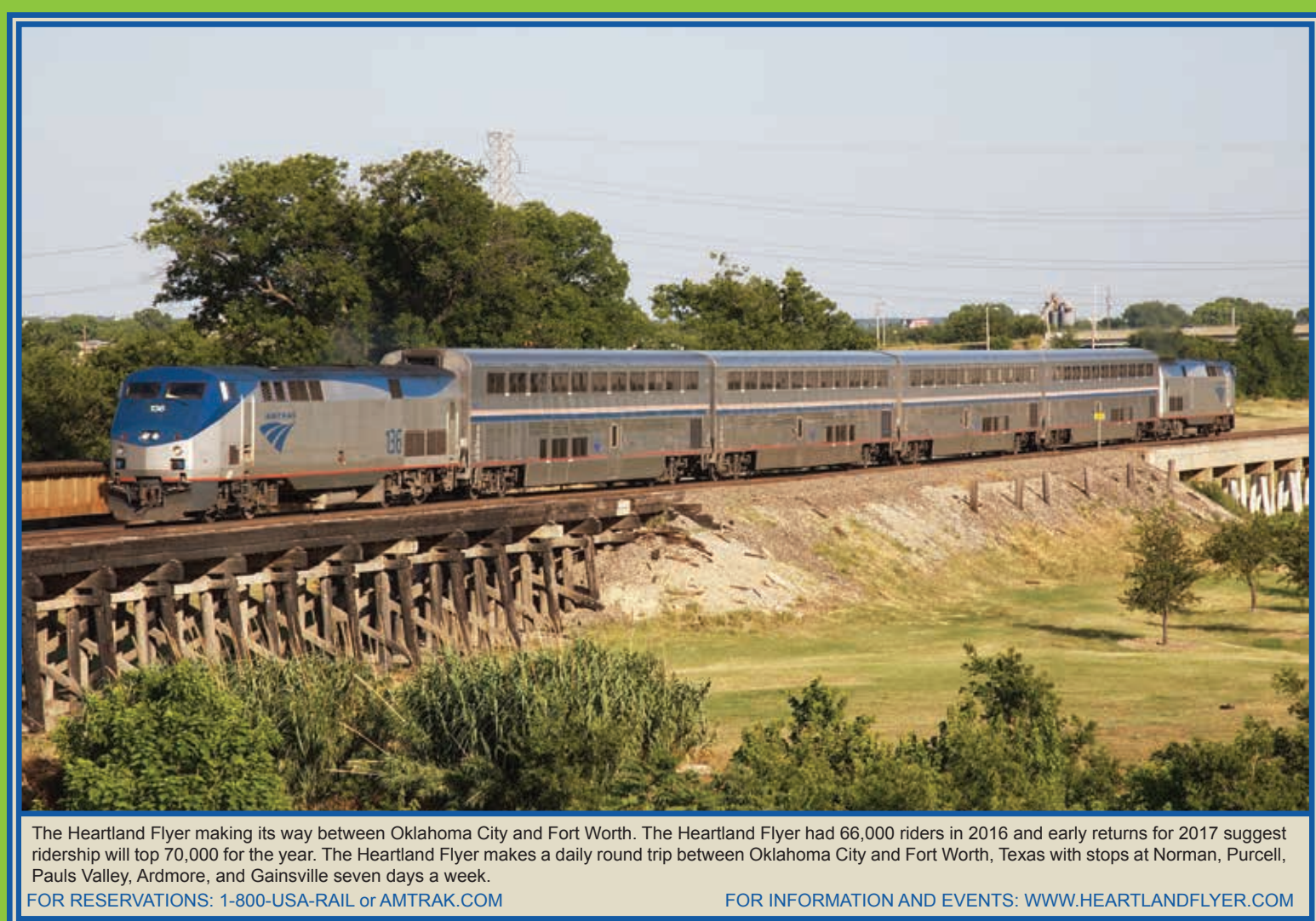

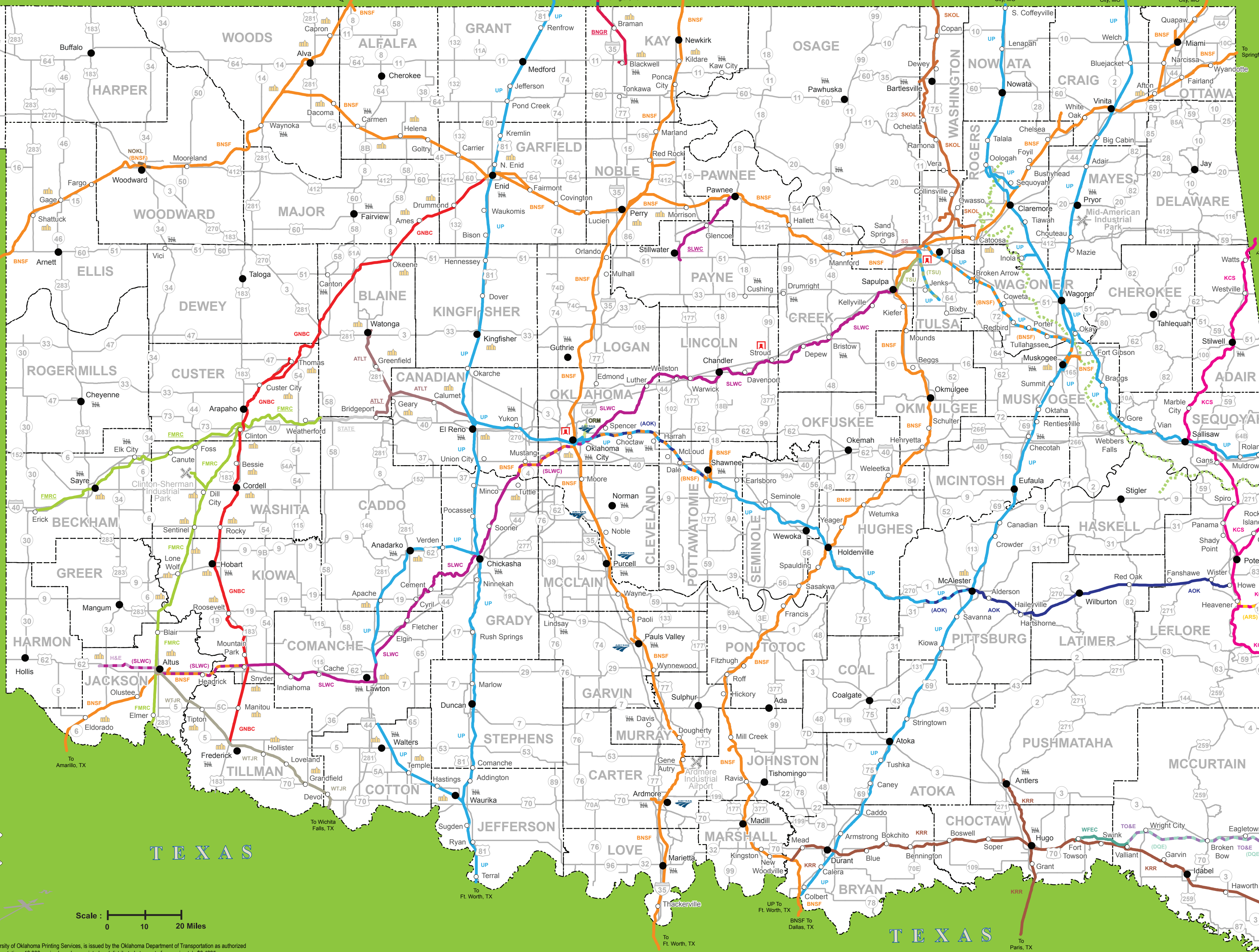
OKLAHOMA 2018-2020 STATE RAILROAD MAP



The Heartland Flyer making its way between Oklahoma City and Fort Worth. The Heartland Flyer had 66,000 riders in 2016 and early returns for 2017 suggest ridership will top 70,000 for the year. The Heartland Flyer makes a daily round trip between Oklahoma City and Fort Worth, Texas with stops at Norman, Purcell, Pauls Valley, Ardmore, and Gainesville seven days a week.
