- 3.1 Listings will be by brand name of product
- Jurisdiction & Correspondence: All correspondence concerning this listing should be directed to the following Jurisdiction:

- Job Acceptance Requirements: No job control samples or product certifications required. Satisfactory listing Field Acceptance Method 5001. If doubt exists on job, submit job control sample to Central Lab with complete explanation of doubt.
- Mix Designer's Requirements: Mix Designers will be responsible to specify only qualified products in their mix designs, identifying them by Product Name.
- Project Engineer's Requirements: Project Engineers will be responsible to inspect and assure all products are verified and documented in accordance with the Field Acceptance Method
- Initial Product Qualification Requirements: Companies wishing to have products evaluated for placement in this listing should furnish the following:
- 8.1 Signed letter requesting evaluation for this listing with:
- 8.2 Name, address, telephone and fax information of Manufacturer
- 8.3 Full product description along with MSDS
- 8.4 Comparison test reports from a creditable laboratory, indicating improvement in TSR value (AASHTO T-283) when added to a mix compared to when not added to the same mix.
- 8.5 Documentation of approval by another State DOT with contact information for the State DOT
- Manufacturer's Maintenance Requirements:
 Manufacturers with products in this listing must comply with the following:
- 9.1 Continue to produce the same quality and product submitted for the evaluation
- 9.2 Promptly report to the Jurisdiction any changes in Manufacturer's name, address, ownership or changes in product name, designation or formulation

- Supplier's Requirements: Suppliers of these types of products must comply with the following:
- 10.1 Supply only qualified products to Department specification projects, identifying Product Name on records with each shipment
- 10.2 Include all Manufacturer's special handling or application instructions with each shipment
- 10.3 Promptly report to the Jurisdiction (and Manufacturer if other than Supplier) any doubt about products or performance
- Contractor's Requirements: Contractors using these types of products on Department specification projects must comply with the following:
- 11.1 Purchase only qualified products and use them in accordance with governing requirements
- 11.2 Promptly report to the Supplier any doubt about products or performance
- 12. <u>Laboratory Testing:</u> The Department will not conduct initial evaluation laboratory testing but will initially evaluate products as follows:
- 12.1 Review submitted comparison test reports for improvement (see 8.4)
- 12.2 Test reports review may be waived with documentation of approval by another State DOT.
- 12.3 Listed products are subject to random periodic verification testing by the Department. Said testing will be performed on samples obtained from Department project concerns.
- 13. <u>Reporting of Evaluation Results:</u> The Jurisdiction will report evaluation results to the following:
- 13.1 Company requesting the evaluation
- 13.2 Manufacturer (if different than 13.1)
- 14. <u>Application of Evaluation Results:</u> The Department's initial evaluation results will be applied as follows:
- 14.1 Satisfactory products are added to this listing
- 14.2 Unsatisfactory products fail to be added to this listing and products are subject to a six (6) month waiting period for re-evaluation.
- 15. <u>Expiration of Products from Listing:</u> Products may be removed or expired from this listing for:
- 15.1 Substitution and/or mislabeling
- 15.2 Failure to meet any of the Department's requirements for these types of products
- 15.3 Failure of the products to perform satisfactorily on the job
- 15.4 An unacceptably long period of time expiring without the products being used on a Department project
