



Notice of Public Meeting

All interested persons are hereby given notice that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) is proposing to reconstruct US 62 through Blanchard. The meeting is scheduled for 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., Thursday, November 13, 2003 at the Blanchard Middle School Cafetorium, 400 North Harrison, Blanchard, Oklahoma.

The purpose of the meeting is to gather public input on the proposed improvements for US 62 in the City of Blanchard. We will discuss the alternatives under consideration, specifically the 5-lane section through the center of town and the horizontal and vertical curves west of Blanchard.

US Highway 62 consists primarily of a two-lane facility. US Highway 62 has numerous intersections and driveways within the proposed project extent. The reconstruction of US 62 will provide citizens traveling this roadway a safer and more efficient transportation facility.
