



Notice of Public Meeting

All interested persons are hereby given notice that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) proposes to upgrade US 287 from approximately 1.5 miles north of Boise City, north to the Oklahoma/Colorado state line in Cimarron County as part of the Ports to Plains Corridor Improvements from Laredo, Texas to Denver, Colorado. ODOT's consultant on this project, Cobb Engineering Company, has scheduled a public meeting to discuss the proposed project. The meeting will be held at 5:30 p.m., Thursday, January 29, 2004, in the Boise City Grade School Cafeteria located at 402 SE 4th in Boise City.

The purpose of the meeting is to present and discuss proposed location, design, and social, economic, and environmental impacts, anticipated right-of-way requirements, tentative construction sequencing and schedules, right-of-way appraisal and acquisition processes involved with the proposed project.
