The meeting is scheduled for 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m, Thursday, February 24, 2005 at the Sapulpa City Hall, City Council Chambers, 425 East Dewey, Sapulpa Oklahoma.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss and gather public input on the proposal to widen a portion of SH 66 from two lane to four lane in the City of Sapulpa, Creek County.

The reconstruction of SH 66 to a four-lane facility from SH 117 east one approximately 1.5 miles to SH 97 in Sapulpa will provide a safe and efficient facility for the traveling public.
