

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

All interested persons are hereby given notice that the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) is proposing to construct an interchange on the Indian Nation Turnpike approximately 1½ miles south of Interstate 40 near Henryetta, Oklahoma. A public meeting is scheduled for 6:00 p.m., Thursday, May 25, 2006, at the Civic Center, 115 S. 4th Street, Henryetta, Oklahoma 74437.

The need of the proposed interchange is to provide improved access to the existing Nichols Park (on the west side of the turnpike) and also to provide access to the property east of the turnpike which currently has no access. The project is in the early stages of development and any comments relative to it would be appreciated. The purpose of this meeting is to request information from the public to further assist ODOT in the identification of potential social, economic, and environmental impacts that may result from the project.
