Public Meeting on State Highway 51 Alternative Routes In Wagoner

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation proposes to upgrade State Highway 51 to meet the increased traffic demands between Wagoner and Tahlequah. The proposed project would involve the addition of travel and turn lanes as necessary along the existing alignment, with bypasses around Wagoner and Hulbert being considered.

Initial public/stakeholder meetings were held in Wagoner in mid-2005. As an outcome of those public meetings ODOT was asked to consider further bypass alternatives. A public meeting will be held to present and discuss these additional alternative bypass routes. The meeting will be conducted at 6:00 PM, Tuesday, October 9, 2007 at the Civic Center located at 301 South Grant in Wagoner, Oklahoma. A brief formal presentation will be followed by an open house with a question and answer session.
