

US-75 Public Meeting Notice

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) proposes to improve US-75 in Wetumka. Proposed improvements include a new alignment of US-75 north of Wetumka and improvements to the existing highway in Wetumka. The purpose of the project is to improve safety of the US-75 facility and improve drainage problems associated with the current roadway.

As part of our efforts to keep the public informed of this project and involved in the decision process, ODOT has scheduled a public meeting. The meeting will include a presentation about the proposed improvements to US-75 including why the improvements are needed, the type of improvements proposed, and the expected impacts to motorists and the surrounding community. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain information from the public to further assist in the identification of critical social, economic and environmental effects that may result from the project.
