Input sought for SH-115 improvements in Meers

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation invites the public to attend a meeting regarding proposed improvements to SH-115 from just north of the Meers Store extending north and west to the previously replaced Jimmy Creek Bridge in Comanche County. The meeting will be held Tuesday, January 15 at 6 p.m. at the Meers Civic Center.

The meeting will include a presentation on the proposed improvements of the two-lane roadway including adding shoulders, improving vertical (hills) and horizontal (curves) alignments and bridge work. SH-115 is designated as a Scenic Byway so public input is needed on how best to improve safety while maintaining the scenic nature of the roadway. Final design and right-of-way requirements for this proposal have not been determined.
