

ODOT is proposing to correct the structural and functional deficiencies of the bridges over the Salt Fork of the Arkansas and Cowskin Creek on SH 156, located 1.1 and 2.8 miles north of the Noble County line in Kay County. The proposed improvements are anticipated to include replacements of the bridges, without any improvements to the roadway.
