

Notice of Public Meeting

US-177: from Junction SH-33 extending South approximately 1.517 miles in the City of Perkins, Payne County, State Project 21932(04) Phase 1

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is proposing to improve US Highway 177 in the City of Perkins. Design plans for the proposed improvements were previously presented to the public. The Department has determined modifications to the design plans regarding the location of drainage structures are needed.

To present the proposed plan revisions a public meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on July 15, 2008 at the Perkins Lions Den, located at 120 S. Main Street, Perkins, OK 74059. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain information from the public to further assist in the identification of critical social, economic and environmental effects that may result from the project.
