- Share information and answer questions concerning the project


Project Information

- **Construction is scheduled to begin in fall of 2008**
- **150 total number of calendar days scheduled for the project**
- **This project has an incentive of \$5,000 per day for opening the highway to traffic in less than 150 days and a disincentive of \$5,000 per day for any closures beyond 150 days.**
- **The bridge width will be two 12' driving lanes with 8' paved shoulders on each side**
