

Notice of Public Meeting

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is considering an interchange at I-40 and Bryan Street in Shawnee in Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma. The purpose of the project is to improve the access to the east part of Shawnee with the proposed interchange and improve mobility to the eastern part of the city by connecting Bryan Street to Interstate 40. The study area includes Bryan Street from 45th Street extending north to Westech Road over I-40.

A public meeting to present initial project information and receive public input will be held on Tuesday, August 5th, at 6:00 pm in the Shawnee Commission Chambers located at 16th West 9th Street, Shawnee. The meeting will include a presentation on the types of interchanges being considered. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain input from the public on the need for the proposed interchange and assist in the identification of critical social, economic and environmental effects that may result from the proposed interchange.
