

The Bridge over the East Branch of Dry Creek was built in 1927.




Why this project is needed:

Even with continued maintenance, over time the bridge has become load posted and has deteriorated to a point of structural deficiency and needs to be replaced.





What will it all look like?




Will there be a Detour?
