

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is proposing to improve US-62 (Rogers Lane) at Sheridan Road and Ft. Sill Boulevard in the City of Lawton.

A public meeting to present project information and receive public input will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 13th, 2010 at the Professional Development Center of the Lawton Public Schools, 2209 NW 25th St., Lawton, Oklahoma. The meeting will include a presentation about the proposed improvements to US-62 including why the improvements are needed, the type of improvements proposed, and the expected impacts to motorists and the surrounding community. The purpose of the meeting is to obtain information from the public to further assist in the identification of critical social, economic and environmental effects that may result from the project.
