The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is re-evaluating the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the segment of SH-9 from 72nd Avenue SE to 84th Avenue SE and is proposing to extend the project an additional two miles east to 108th Avenue SE in the City of Norman. An EA for the SH-9 corridor from 24th Avenue SE to 84th Avenue SE was completed by ODOT and a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) was issued by FHWA in 2011. The purpose of the proposed improvement is to meet increasing traffic demands and public safety needs through this section of SH-9.

A public meeting is being held to present the re-evaluation of the EA and the proposed project extension. The purpose of the meeting is to get public input for the project extension.
