NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is proposing to improve a section of State Highway 9 from east of the Stinking Creek Bridge in Kiowa County through the State Highway 58 intersection in Carnegie in Caddo County. Existing State Highway 9 has narrow or no shoulders, several sharp curves and rolling terrain which results in inadequate sight distance to see oncoming traffic or turning traffic. These factors contribute to a substantial accident history and indicate unsafe conditions. The purpose of the project is to improve the safety of the roadway.

ODOT has recently developed alternatives to improve this section of State Highway 9, while taking into consideration construction costs, right-of-way costs and environmental constraints. The purpose of this meeting is to present these alternatives and solicit comments relevant to the Department's proposed improvements to this section of State Highway 9.
