The Oklahoma Department of Transportation is extending the public comment period for the Oklahoma City Boulevard until June 13, 2014. The decision to continue to accept comments longer than the standard 14-day period was made after careful consideration of the public comments and questions received to date. Additional information will be posted on ODOT's website at www.okladot.state.ok.us on or before May 30, in order to help address questions and eliminate confusion on the project. All comments received to date, as well as new comments, are important and will be considered as part of the overall environmental process.

ODOT and the City of Oklahoma City are asking local citizens to take advantage of the longer comment period to voice their opinions about their priorities for the Boulevard. The public is encouraged to continue to check ODOT's website for additional information that is being made available.
