SUBJECT: Revision to the State Highway System


The following highway revisions are necessitated by new construction on US 59 between Howe and Poteau.

Add to the State Highway System two segments of road (1) to be designated as US Highway 59, beginning at the old road near the south edge of Howe and extending northerly 4.9 miles to its junction with the old road south of Poteau; and (2) to be designated as State Highway 83, beginning at its junction with the new location of US Highway 59 and extending east to its junction with the old location of US 59, a distance of 0.4 mile.

Transfer from the State Highway System a segment of old road designated as US Highway 59, beginning at its junction with the new road near the south edge of Howe and extending northerly to its junction with the new road south of Poteau, a distance of 5.4 miles. This segment of old road will be transferred to LeFlore County or the City of Poteau, as applicable. A public hearing has been held on this removal, as required by State Law.

This revision to the State Highway System will become effective upon the completion of construction of FAP Projects RF-225(33) (34) and (35).

The Department recommends approval of this item.
