

PRESENTED AT COMMISSION MEETING OF SEPTEMBER 7, 1999

SUBJECT: State Highway System Revision
Relocation of US 59 and SH 100 in Stilwell
COUNTY: Adair

This item is necessitated by the relocation of US 59 in Stilwell in Adair County. Construction Project STP 329 (63).

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new highway to be designated US 59, beginning south of Stilwell at a tie with the existing facility in Section 2, T15N, R24E and extending northerly 1.83 miles to a tie with the existing facility north of Stilwell in Section 35, T16N, R24E.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new highway to be designated SH 100, beginning at the junction of old US 59 and extending east 0.09 mile to the new US 59.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new highway to be designated SH 100, beginning at the junction of the new US 59 and extending east 0.07 mile to the junction of old US 59.

Add SH 100 designation to US 59, beginning at the junction of US 59 and SH 100 south of Stilwell and extending northerly 0.54 mile to the junction of US 59 and SH 100 on Locust Street in Stilwell.

Remove from the State Highway System a portion of US 59, beginning south of Stilwell in Section 2, T15N, R24E and extending northerly 1.84 miles. This section of old US 59 including right-of-way will be transferred to the appropriate local jurisdiction for further maintenance. In accordance with state law, a Public Removal Hearing was held August 10, 1999.

These revisions will become effective upon approval by the State Transportation Commission and completion of certification that the old roadway meets mandated criteria.

The Department recommends approval of this item.

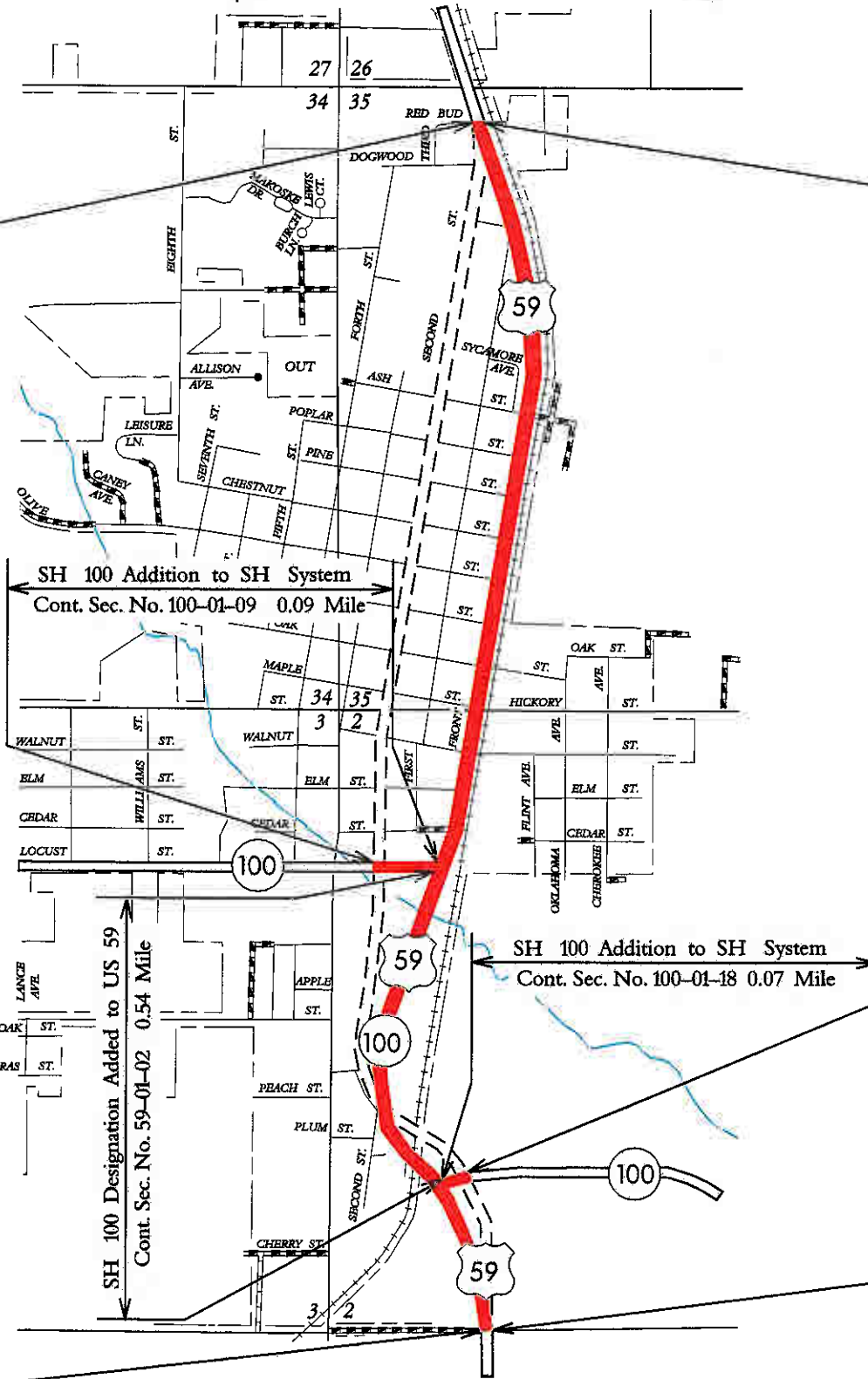

Cont. Sec. No. 59-01-02 1.84 Miles

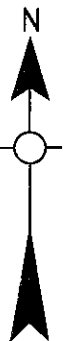
US 59 Addition to SH System

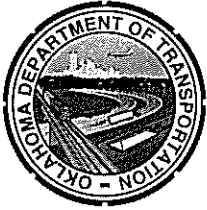
