
US Highway 59 and 271 and State Highway 112 - Relocation - LeFlore County

Remove from the State Highway System a segment of old road designated as US Highway 59 and 27l beginning at the intersection of McKenna Avenue with Conser Street thence northerly on McKenna Avenue to Dewey Street at its junction with State Highway 112 a distance of 0.5 mile. This segment of old road will be transferred to the City of Poteau for further maintenance or abandonment.

Redesignate a segment of US Highway 59 and 271 as State Highway 112 in Poteau beginning at the intersection of Front Avenue with Beard Street and extending easterly to the intersection of Dewey Street with McKenna Avenue a distance of 0.1 mile.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of road to be designated as US Highway 59 and 271 in Poteau beginning at the intersection of Conser Street with McKenna Avenue thence westerly on Conser Street to Front Avenue, thence northerly to the intersection of Front Avenue with Beard Street, a distance of 0.6 mile.

The Oklahoma State Highway Commission in regular session July 6, 1/64, Item 149 a, approved the following revision in the State Highway System.

Remove from the State Digimey System a segment of old road designated as US Digimey 59 and 271, beginning at the intersection of McKenna Avenue with Conser Street, thence northerly on McKenna Avenue to Dowey Street at its junction with State Highway 112, a distance of 0.5 mile. This segment of old road will be transferred to the City of Potesu for further maintenance or absolutement.

Redemignate a segment of US Highway 59 and 271 as State Highway 112 in Poteen, beginning at the intersection of Front Avenue with Beard Street and extending centerly to the intersection of Dewey Street with McKenna Avenue, a distance of O.1 mile.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of road to be designated as US Highway 59 and 271 in Potenn, beginning at the intersection of Conser Street with McKenna Avenue, thence westerly on Conser Street to Pront Avenue, thence northerly to the intersection of Front Avenue with Beard Street, a distance of 0.6 mile.
