

Redesignate US Highway 60 as US Highway 60 Business, beginning at the Missouri State line near Seneca, Missouri, and extending southwesterly to the junction with the new location; a distance of 0.9 mile.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as US Highway 60, beginning at the junction with the old road and extending east to the Missouri State line southwest of Seneca, Missouri, a distance of 0.4 mile.


