

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as US Highway 60 beginning at its junction with the old road on the section line at the $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}$ of Section 29, T26N, R15E and extending east to its junction with the old road, a distance of 1.0 mile.

This revision to the State Highway System will become effective upon the completion of construction of FAP Project F-190(18). This revision has been reviewed and is recommended by the Route Numbering Committee.
