

This item is necessitated by the construction of new bridge of US 60 on new alignment west of Arnett in Ellis County. Construction Project BRFY 019N (001).

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new highway to be designated US 60, beginning at a tie with the existing facility in Section 10, T19N, R26W and extending west approximately 0.73 mile to a tie with existing facility in Section 9, T19N, R26W west of Arnett.

Remove from the State Highway System a portion of US 60, beginning at the new construction in Section 10, T19N, R26W and extending west approximately 0.7 mile to new construction west of Arnett. This portion of old US 60 roadway surface was removed and Right of Way retained by the State..

This revision become effective upon completion of construction.
