SUBJECT: Origin of US 60 in Oklahoma

Based upon miscellaneous documents available in Current Planning, it appears that US 60 originated in 1930. In western Oklahoma, US 164 was redesignated US 60 from the Texas State line via Arnett and Fairview to Enid. From Enid, US 60 was extended via Pond Creek, Ponca City, Pawhuska, Bartlesville, Vinita, Afton and Fairland to the Missouri State line just west of Seneca, Missouri.
