US Highway 60; 77, and 177 Relocation Kay County

Transfer from the State Highway System a segment of old road designated as US Highway 60, 77 and 177 beginning at the SW corner of Section 34, T 26N, R I E and extending east to its junction with the new road southwest of Ponca City, a distance of 4.4 miles. This segment of old road will be transferred to Kay for further maintenance or abandonment.

Add to the State Highway System a temporary segment of road to be designated as US Highway 60, 77 and 177 beginning at the SW corner of section 34, T 26N, R I E and extending north to its junction with the new road a distance of 0.5 mile.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as US Highway 60, 77 and 177 beginning at its junction at the west  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section line of Section  $3^4$ , T 26N, R I E and extending easterly to its junction with the old road southwest of Ponca City a distance of 4.5 miles.


Transfer from the State Highway System a segment of old road designated as US Highway 60 Business Route beginning at its junction with US Highway 60, 77 and 177 at the intersection of Waverly Street with Harding Avenue and extending north to South Avenue a distance of 1.0 mile. This segment of old road will be transferred to Kay County or the City of Ponca City for further maintenance or abandonment.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as US Highway 60 Business Route beginning at its junction with the new location of US Highway 60, 77 and 177 and extending easterly to the intersection of South Avenue with Pine Street thence north to Grand Avenue and east to its junction with US Highway 77 at the intersection of Fourteenth Street thence south to its junction with US Highway 60 at Harding Avenue a distance of 5.7 miles.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of road to be designated as State Highway 156 beginning its junction with the old location of US Highway 60; 77 and 177 and extending north to its junction with the new location at US Highway 60; 77 and 177 a distance at 0.5 mile.

These revisions to the State Highway System will become effective upon the completion of construction of FAP Project F-283 (7).



At its meeting in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, on October the 26th the Executive Committee took the following action on requests by your Department for changes in the U. S. Route Numbered System in Oklahoma.

The relocation of U. S. Routes 60, 77, and 177 and the designation of a Business Route on U. S. 60 in Ponca City were approved.

The relocation of U. S. Route 62 near Headrick, U. S. Route 64 in Sand Springs and U. S. 270 at McAlester were all approved.

Your request for the extension of U. S. Route 377 from Madill to Cleveland was unanimously denied on the same grounds as previously. However, the Committee will again consider this application if and when this route has been brought up to the necessary geometric design standards required for modern traffic.
