
Redesignate US Highway 60 as US Highway 60 Business beginning at its junction with US Highway 177 east of Tonkawa and extend east through Tonkawa on Main Street to North Street, thence north to its junction with US Highway 60 north of Tonkawa, a distance of 2.5 miles.

Add US Highway 60 designation on US Highway 177 beginning at its junction east of Tonkawa and extending north to its junction with the new road, a distance of 0.5 mile.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as US Highway 60 beginning at its junction north of Tonkawa and extending easterly to its junction with US Highway 177, a distance of 1.6 miles.

This segment of new road has been constructed as FAP Project 283(4)(5)(20).
