

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as State Highway 148 beginning at its junction with the new location of US Highway 62 and extending south to the junction with the old location a distance of 0.3 mile.

The entire length of State Highway 148 thru Barber will be removed from the State Highway System upon completion of performance of satisfactory maintenance by Commission Action of March 4, 1963, Item E 45 B.

The Oklahoma State Highway Commission in regular session January 6, 1964, Item 8 A, approved the following revision in the State Highway System.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as US Highway 62 beginning at its Junction with State Highway 10 and extending easterly to its Junction with the old location a distance of 1.3 miles.

Add to the State Highway System a segment of new road to be designated as State Highway 148 beginning at its Junction with the new location of US Highway 62 and extending south to the Junction with the old location a distance of 0.3 mile.

The entire length of State Highway 148 thru Barber will be removed from the State Highway System upon completion of performance of satisfactory maintenance by Commission Action of March 4, 1963, Item E 45 B.
